The Forum covers the whole country since 2011 in Regional Sessions, has gone through Cuiabá, Rio de Janeiro, Belo Horizonte, Vitória, Brasilia and Fortaleza, to discuss and refine a proposed "Technical Guidance" prepared by IBEC to align the current differences associated budgeting for public works and projects. 1st Brazilian Costs Forum of Public Works

he IBEC held since November 2011, the 1st Brazilian Costs of Public Works in order to equalize the conceptual differences regarding the cost of public works, which are mainly present in the relations between public agencies contracting, Public Bodies Audit and Inspection and businesses construction, the IBEC proposes the establishment of a Technical Guidance to allow budgeting pre-bidding within the existing technical criteria in Cost Engineering.

This Forum is being held in a shifting in major Brazilian cities, where trade associations, government agencies, associations and unions, so all these local, state and federal, are giving full support to their achievement. The organization of this Forum is led by IBEC, which is providing its technical team of experts in engineering costs to consolidate the proposals presented and their operational staff for planning

and conducting these events. The financial viability for the sessions of the Forum has been made possible by the Associations and the interested public agencies.

The final event of this Forum will be in São Paulo, where it will then be discussed and approved the final version of the THECNICAL GUIDANCE proposed. The Forum takes place in regional sessions and has toured the

cities of Cuiabá / MT, Rio de Janeiro / RJ, Belo Horizonte / MG, Vitótia / ES, Brasilia / DF, Fortaleza / CE. The city of Florianópolis / SC will receive the next and final Regional Session. The National Meeting will take place on August 3 in Sao Paulo, which will also be broadcast via videoconference free!

n order to consolidate the Brazilian engineering costs on the international scene, the IBEC aims to host in BRAZIL, in 2016, the World Congress on Cost Engineering sponsored by ICEC (International Cost Engineering Council). The next event takes place in 2012 in Durban, South Africa, where the IBEC will present its proposal. In 2014, it will be time in Milan, Italy, receiving the appointment.

Brazil is a strong candidate for 2016, since the next year will host sporting events (World Cup 2014 and 2016 Olympic Games) and is currently hosting the Rio +20, planetary grouping that aims to define proposals for environmental sustainability especially for the climate issue.


The intention is to enable free access to works anywhere in the world. In addition, works are obligatory references to the practice of Cost Engineering in Brazil.
